

KEY OFFICIALS TO BE APPOINTED BY THE NF/MO UNDER THE SAFEGUARDING POLICY

Safeguarding Officer	Supervises the processes (information dissemination, reporting, investigation etc.) as described in this Policy at the NF/MO level.
	Receives reports/complaints regarding safeguarding violations/incidents.
Event Safeguarding Officer	Person responsible for ensuring that the safeguarding policy is enforced and maintained at the events and competitions at NF/MO level.
	Acts as the first point of contact for anyone in need during the events and competitions.

It is important that Safeguarding Officer(s):

- ⚙ Have considerable expertise or possess experience in the field of safeguarding;
- ⚙ Are certified by a recognized body with course(s) on safeguarding;
- ⚙ Should attend regular workshops/training sessions on safeguarding from recognized bodies/institutes/universities;
- ⚙ Be a known figure, especially when being appointed to local/MO levels and should be ideally involved in the day-to-day activities at local/MO level;
- ⚙ Be approachable by athletes, especially children and others, for the purpose of reporting a forbidden conduct or violation of this Policy.

DUTIES OF THE NF/MO UNDER THE POLICY

- ⚙ Adopting and implementing a Safeguarding Policy
- ⚙ Identifying, collating, and adhering to applicable national and local laws regarding safeguarding
- ⚙ Appointing necessary safeguarding officials
- ⚙ Informing about safeguarding policies to all stakeholders, and promoting good safeguarding practices
- ⚙ Providing appropriate training opportunities to all stakeholders regarding safeguarding policies and procedure
